What You Can Crowdsource!

Many task-sourcing sites offer a TON of value. All you have to do is delegate a task out ONCE and then have hundreds of people rush to help you.

While there are a TON of sites out there, my personal 2 favorite are <u>Microworkers</u> and <u>Mechanical Turk</u>.

There seems to be the most people on these 2 sites and turnaround is the fastest.

With both sites, you only pay AFTER you're satisfied with the work.

Microworkers makes you wait until they approve your campaign, so that can be a drag sometimes. The plus side is that once they do approve you, work is VERY fast. You can also choose the countries you want people to be from for certain tasks (for example, you might want people from the U.S. or Australia for article writing).

They have pre-set prices for different tasks and you can only pay more than their minimum.

Mechanical Turk is immediate and you can set your own price for tasks. They're just much less flexible on tasks now and you don't have any say as to which country people are from.

Here's a fast-action list of what you can do with both of these sites:

YouTube	Yes	Some Cases	You can have people on Microworkers add your video to their favorites, rate it, comment on it, or subscribe to it. With Mechanical Turk, you can just ask for their comments about a video.
Facebook	Yes	No	With Microworkers you can have them like your page, comment on conversations, change their profile photos, add you as a friend, post to your wall, like your post, or add an application.

Ask people for their opinions	Yes	Yes	For example, if you want to address questions about something (like weight loss) you can get lots of ideas here.
Basic virtual assistant work	Yes	Yes	With Microworkers you would post this under "Other". Example VA work would be verifying phone numbers, finding websites, identifying contact information, and other basic web/ phone research.
Data Cleansing	Yes	Yes	This would go under "Other" for Microworkers. You can ask people to identify and correct duplicate postings, correct spelling errors, or find missing data and information.
Review content	Yes	Yes	If you get a ton of information and want to see what's relevant to your site, both of these services can have people mine through the content for you. Simply choose "Other" in Microworkers.

Get feedback on your business	Yes	Yes	You can ask for feedback on websites, logos, search functionality, pictures, functionality of a program or anything else about a site.
